

Instructions to Students –Sem-II/Sem-IV Online Backlog Examination November 2020

As per the University of Mumbai guidelines vide circular No. Exam /DBOEE/ICC/2020-21-11 dated 3rd November 2020, the following guidelines are given which are related to students regarding online Backlog examination for Sem-II and Sem-IV.

- The format of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) for external evaluation of F.Y.
 Sem-II and S.Y. Sem-IV backlog examinations to be conducted during November 24th -November 26th, 2020 for the Academic Year 2019-20.
- 2. MCQ papers will comprise of 25 MCQ. It will be of 1-hour duration and maximum 50 marks.
- 3. The mode of the examination is online with Zoom platform and the Google form link of the respective question paper. The students have to join the Zoom meeting at least 15 minutes before the start of the examination. The link for Zoom meeting will be posted on Whatsapp group of Backlog students.
- 4. The students must ensure that they make themselves properly aware of the syllabus, paper pattern, timetable and technical platform used by the college. Thus, they must take the examinations as per the time-table schedule prescribed by the college and should make requisite arrangements (Smartphone/Laptop/Tab/Desktop/any other gadget, Internet Connectivity) to appear for the online examination.
- 5. Students should not resort to the use of unfair means while attempting the examination. Colleges will initiate action for use of unfair means as per University rules and regulations.
- 6. Since this is an online examination, there will not be any revaluation.
- 7. Students should refer to and follow instructions given by the College and as directed by university.
- 8. Do not believe in messages spread on any social media platform.
