

**Important Instructions to Students appearing for  
M.Com. Part II Sem – III Regular Online Examination  
December 2021**

1. As per University guidelines vide circular No. Exam No. Exam/DBOEE/ICC/2020-21/ 15 dated 18th November 2020, has adopted the format of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) for external evaluation. All Examinations mentioned above are taken online starting from **21<sup>st</sup> December 2021. University Time table main and Revised uploaded on website kindly check carefully.**
2. The time table for the ONLINE EXAMINATION and the STUDENT LIST appearing for the examination are uploaded on the College Website.

3. You may not be able to appear for the exam if web camera attached to your system is not functional. The web camera of your system must be enabled and must remain switched on throughout the examination. In the event of non-receipt of a webcam, your examination will be considered as null and void.
4. Your exam activity will be monitored by the proctor and your exam will get terminated if you try any unfair practice.
5. Use of headphones and phone calls is not permissible during the exam.
6. Breaks are not allowed during the examination. As you are not allowed to deviate from your seat, keep all necessary items like Rough sheets, simple calculator and pen with you.
7. Do not use the alt-tab, mouse or any other device to shift from examination screen to any other screen or do not try to open any other application while attempting the examination. Doing so may result in termination of examination and your examination will be considered as null and void.
8. System requirements:
  - **Personal Laptop or Desktop computer or Smartphone** in working conditions.
  - **Quality camera.** In case you're desktop does not have a camera, use USB camera.
  - **Operating system:** Desktop - Windows 7 and above  
Mobile – Android/iOS
  - **Browser:** Latest version of Google Chrome.
  - **Internet speed** should be minimum 1 MBPs.
  - Mobile Phone user must **disable all notification** such as WhatsApp, SMS,

9. Please check the Day, Date and Timing of the Examination properly.
10. The format of Question paper will be Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) consists of **50 questions** carrying **1 mark** each. Students have to attempt **all 50 questions.**
11. Each Paper will be of one-hour duration carrying **50 marks** and will be conducted **ONLINE.**
12. Examination link will be opened for **ONE HOUR ONLY** and no examination will be accepted after the link is closed.
13. The examination link will be shared on your **registered EMAIL ID** one day prior to each paper.
