Poster Competition Winners:

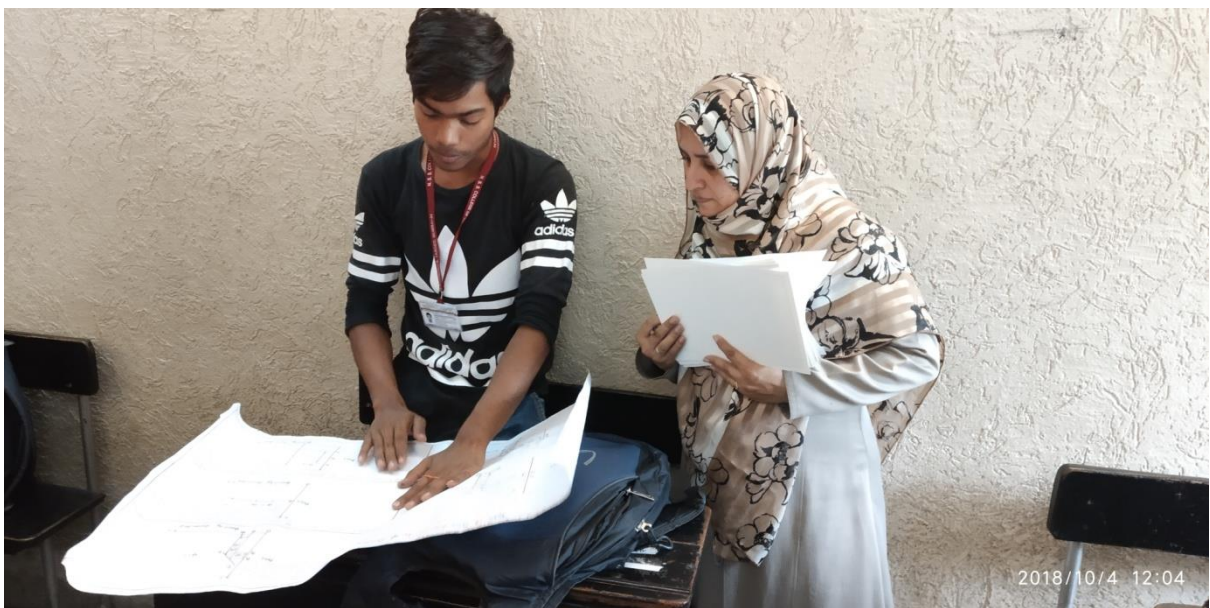

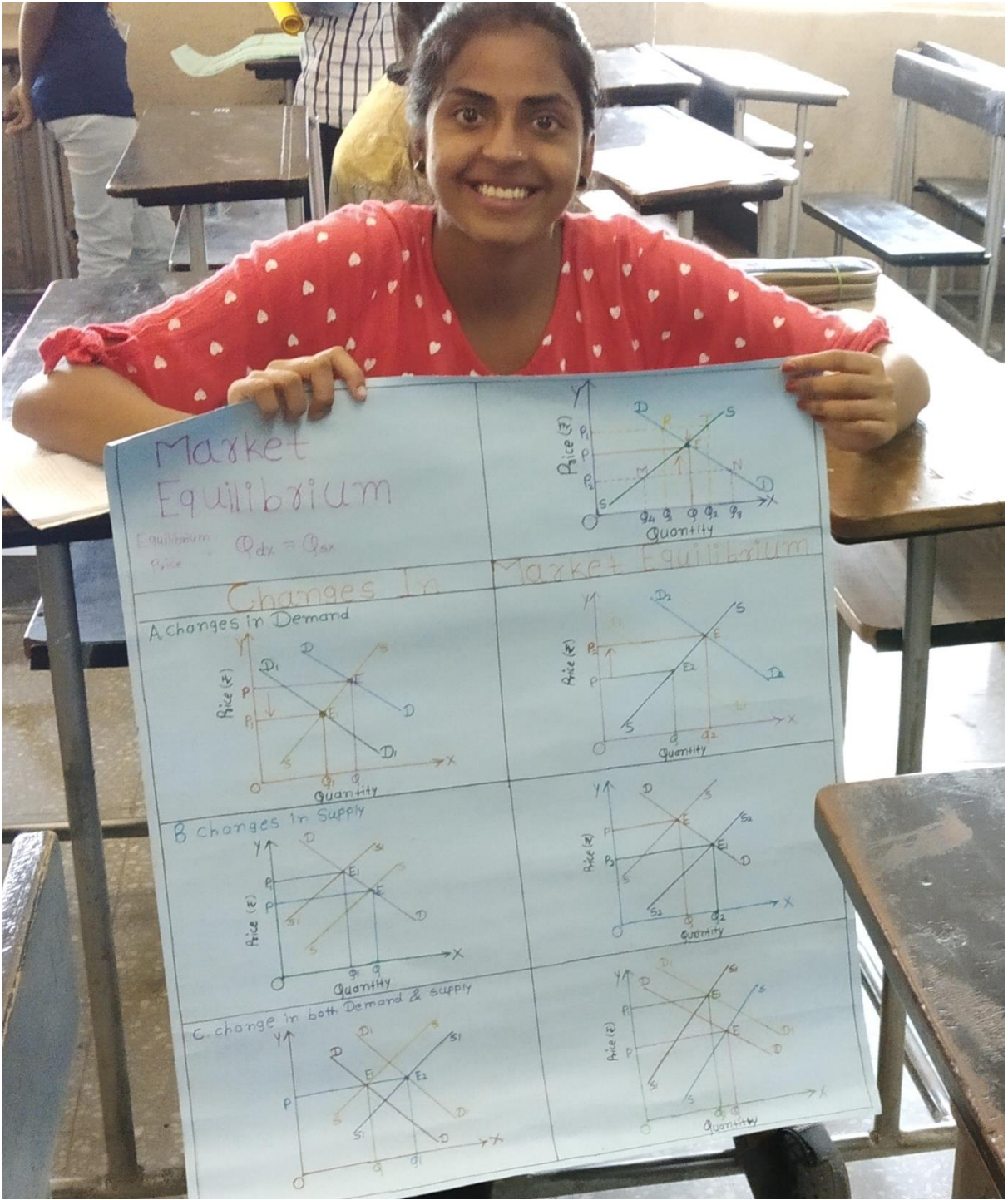

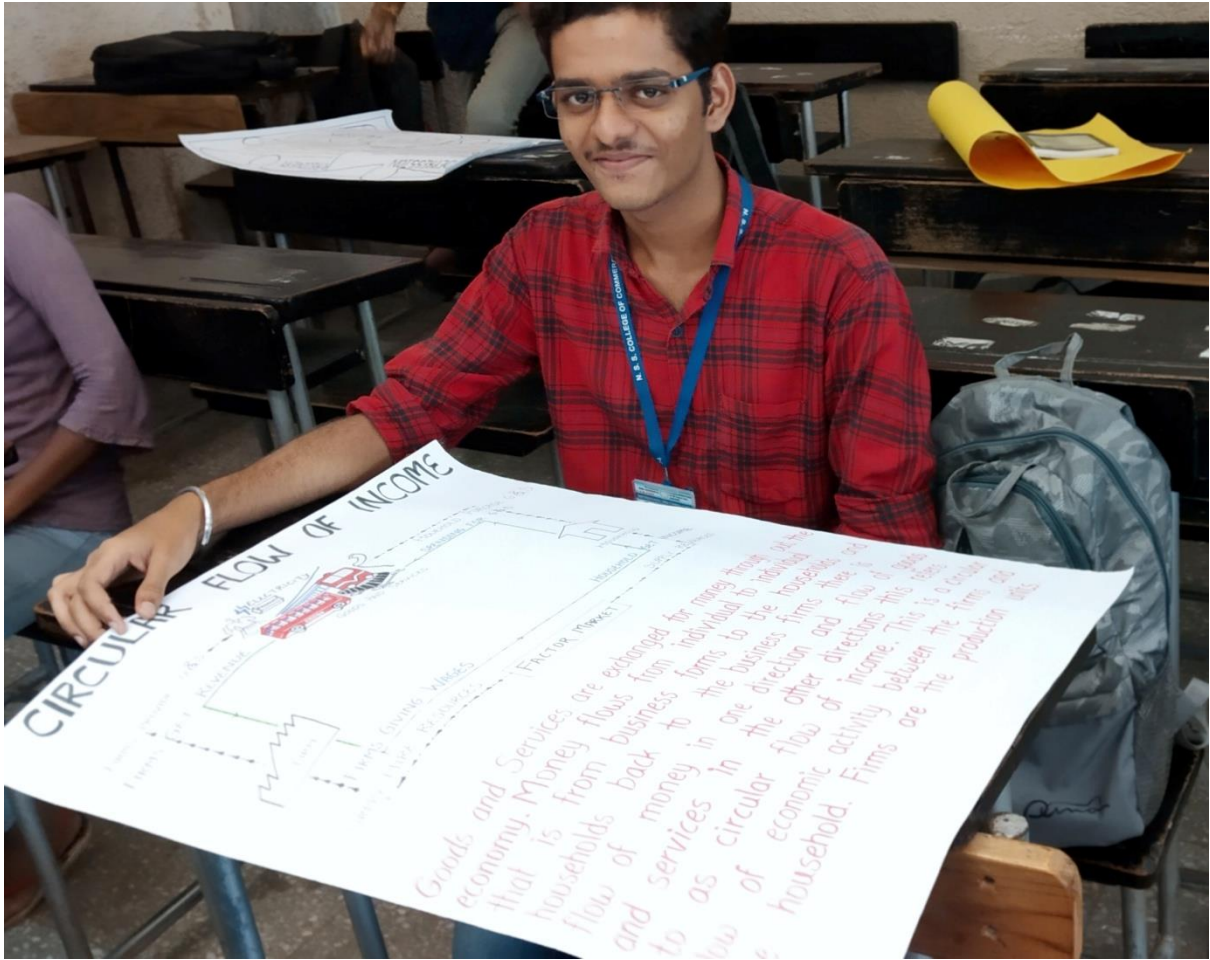
